

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Find another person to design your Christmas card with. (See rules for details)
- 2. Print out the design sheet (A4) and create your picture to fit inside the rectangle. Make sure it does not go outside of the lines.
- 3. Complete the entry form
- 4. Scan or photograph the whole design sheet including your picture the heading and the white border.
- 5. Email info@commongoodschools.co.uk with entry form and design sheet.

#### **RULES**

- 1. Registration is free
- 2. The design must be created in collaboration with a member of the local community. This can include family members, friends from other schools and trusted adults from clubs, groups and organisations.
- 3. Artwork should be inspired by the Bible verse 'The Word became flesh and blood and moved into the neighbourhood.' John 1:14 (The Message) and should represent people and places in your local area.
- 4. Competitors may use any medium/technique, but please keep in mind that this will be printed onto a card, so should be flat to the paper (2D)
- 5. Photography will not be accepted.
- 6. The closing date for entries to be received is Friday 29th November 2024.
- 7. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 8. Your artwork and completed entry form should be submitted via email to <a href="mailto:info@commongoodschools.co.uk">info@commongoodschools.co.uk</a>
- 9. By completing and submitting the entry form you are agreeing to the competition rules.
- 10. The Christmas Card printed with the winning design will credit the artists and their school and/or community group on the reverse of the card.
- 11. Artists of the three best designs will receive some Christmas chocolates, a pack of Christmas cards printed with their design and a certificate of achievement.

#### **JUDGING CRITERIA**

- Any entries not complying to the competition rules will not be put forward for judging.
- 2. Artwork will be judged by a panel comprising representatives from the staff, friends and Trustees of Together for the Common Good.
- 3. The panel will assess the quality of the artwork, creativity, originality, reflecting the theme of bible verse John 1:14 and the local area, and the overall impression of the work.
