MARKETING & COMMS ASSISTANT

Assist in creating online and physical marketing materials for launch of new programmes - KS2 from Dec 2025 to end of Feb 2026, and KS1 in 2026 (dates tbc).

Approx 2-4 hours per week.

Key skills and experience:

- Social media: X.com, LinkedIn, Facebook, Instagram
- Working in a team
- Liaising with comms partner

Remote working: these roles will involve working online, connecting by Zoom, email, WhatsApp & occasional in-person meetings.
